


PHD RURAL DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION

PHD Rural Development Foundation, the social arm of the **PHD Chamber of Commerce & Industry**, New Delhi; actively works in the areas of Healthcare-*Arogya*, Education-*Shiksha*, Skill Development-*Saksham*, Water Conservation-*Jal Sanchayan* and over Village development. During 2020-21, a total of 21 different projects were undertaken with support from various donors. **PHDRDF impacted lives of more than 1.5 L people across 11 states covering 44 Districts.** During the period, 24 Rain Water Harvesting structures including check dams and pond rejuvenation were established creating a water holding capacity of 28.19 Lakhs cu ft; **37 health camps** were organized under difficult circumstances in 10 states treating more than **7100** patients; 300 + young girls & women and youth were trained in different skill sets; 15 Government schools upgraded with better infrastructure facilities benefitting more than 2500 children.

PHDRDF- SAKSHAM – SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Saksham- Skill development increases opportunities for the people to find sustainable employment or become entrepreneurs. **PHDRDF-Saksham** works towards empowering the rural youth, young girls & Women through training & capacity building in various skill set. During the period, PHDRDF undertook Electrician training for youth, stitching & tailoring, beauty culture, computer training, spoken English language skills, soft skills etc. PHDRDF also established women SHG based enterprises for Sanitary Napkin Manufacturing in remote locations. Market linkage/ placement were also provided to the trained to be financially independent.

Overview of the Skill Development Project Implemented by PHD Rural Development Foundation

A. PHDRDF-DOW AGROSCIENCES INDIA LTD



Dow Agro Sciences India Ltd. has partnered with PHDRDF to implement a project for empowering rural women by training them on “Beekeeping” as a supplementary source of income. A total of 200 women were trained in bee keeping with 100 each in Bawal, Haryana and Pune, Maharashtra. The project was launched in the presence of Dr Ashok Dalwai, Chairman Committee on Doubling the Farmer’s Income by 2022. The programme aimed at making these women as beacons who will motivate and support other women to start their own enterprises and thus get additional income and empower them. All women were provided with 5 bee

boxes each with bee hives i.e. 1000 bee boxes were distributed among women. The women were trained in bee keeping with support from local KVKS.

B. PHDRDF- BRY-AIR (ASIA) PVT. LTD

PHDRDF with support from BRY –Air (Asia) Pvt Ltd undertook Bry-Air Udaan Skill Development Centre for electrician training in Sidhrawali village, Haryana. A total of 40 students were trained in electrician course in Sidhrawali village of Gurugram. The students were assessed by third party assessment agency ‘ShikshaBharati’ which will aid the students in better placement. More than 60% of the students have started their own work in their respective villages and earning an average of Rs 10,000/- to 12,000/- on a monthly basis.



C. PHDRDF - DONALDSON INDIA FILTER SYSTEMS PRIVATE LIMITED



PHDRDF in collaboration with Donaldson Filters India Pvt. Ltd. has established a “Skill Development Centre” since last 5 years in village Mohammadpur Gurjar, Sohna block, Gurugram and have trained 386 women and adolescent girls in stitching and tailoring and beauty culture. Besides, the main course these students are also being provided with English and Soft skill training to enhance their life skills. During the period, a total of 80 adolescent girls were trained in skill set. The girls have gained confidence and are working on their own and earning an average of Rs 5000 per month. They are happy to support their families financially. During Corona Virus outbreak, the centre initiated maintaining physical distance and precaution where the girls were being trained to make cloth mask in collaboration with one of the local hospitals.

D. PHDRDF-THDC- SEWA



PHDRDF and THDC- SEWA has come together for a women empowerment and livelihood generation project through sanitary napkins manufacturing at Bhaniyawala, Jolly Grant, Dehradun. A women SHG comprising of 9 women have been trained in production of sanitary napkins. A saving bank account in the name of 'Sahaj SHG' was opened in a centralized bank. Various marketing channel for the sale of the product have been established.

E. PHDRDF- DRI PVT LTD

PHDRDF with support from DRI Pvt. Ltd. undertook skill development training in Computer training in Sidhrawali village of Pataudi block of Gurugram, Haryana for 60 adolescent girls and women. The project was launched and inaugurated in presence Mr. Deepak Pahwa, Chairman, Pahwa Group; Ms. Anandita Pahwa, Head CSR Initiative of the Pahwa group; Mr. Sanjay Bhatia, Chairman PHDRDF; Dr Kadambari, CEO, PHDRDF; Sarpanch of the Village and other representatives from both the organizations and villagers. The girls feel more confident after undertaking the courses and are able to access the relevant digital information efficiently.



F. PHDRDF-DCM SHRIRAM INDUSTRIES LTD.

PHDRDF and DCM Shriram Industries Ltd. came together for a women empowerment and livelihood generation project through sanitary napkins manufacturing. 'Urmila' Women Self Help Group with 9 women has been formed at Ranikhet in village Pantkotuli on September 2020. The women at the centre have been trained in sanitary napkin manufacturing and are into production of the product independently. Awareness generation on menstrual hygiene is being conducted in various villages of Ranikhet. A saving bank account in the name of 'Urmila Self Help Group' has been opened in a centralized bank and has been running smoothly. The women SHG has already accumulated funds of more than 50,000/- in their SHG account through selling sanitary products prepared by them.



PHDRDF – AROGYA - HEALTHCARE INTERVENTION

PHDRDF has been actively conducting free health camps for the less privileged and low income population in various geographical locations across the country to improve access to healthcare which is an important precondition to socio economic development. During the period, PHDRDF conducted a total of 37 health camps providing diagnostics and health services to more than 7100 patients across 06 states.

Brief Overview of the Healthcare Projects Implemented by PHD Rural Development Foundation

A. PHDRDF- NATIONAL SAFAI KARAMCHARI FINANCE DEVELOPMENT & CORPORATION


PHDRDF with support of National Safai Karamchari Finance Development & Corporation (NSKFDC), Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment successfully organized 33 health camps in 33 districts in five states -Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Orissa, Jharkhand and Assam during the year 2021-22. A team of 12 Medical and Paramedical staff including one physician, one eye specialist, one gynaecologist, one dermatologist and one paediatrician along with paramedical staff were present in each camp. Around 6600 patients were treated and provided free medicine in each camp. Facilities like testing of blood pressure, blood sugar, ECG, eye testing were provided and free medicines and spectacles were distributed. Currently, for the year 2021-22, PHDRDF has been awarded additional 15 health camps to be organized in 4 states - Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, Odisha and Bihar.





B. PHDRDF - ROTARY CLUB OF ROORKEE

PHDRDF has partnered with Rotary Club of Roorkee, Rotary International, Rotary District grant through THDC, Rishikesh for a project **“Mobile Medical Sehat Van”** to provide health services to the villagers of 15 villages of Pratapnagar and Jakhanidhar block of Tehri Gharwal. The project will focus on providing healthcare services through Telemedicine and will reach out to more than 12,000 people in the far flung areas. The project was virtually inaugurated on June 28, 2021 in the presence of Mr. Sanjay Bhatia, Chairman PHDRDF; Mr. Saurabh Sanyal, Secretary General PHDCCI; Mr. Shekhar Mehta, Rotary International President Elect; Mr. Hemant Arora, PDG, Rotary Club of Midtown Roorkee; Mr. R Vishnoi, Director Technical THDC SEWA; Mr. Nathani, GM CSR; Mr. Rakesh Khare, Ex ED THDC; Dr Kadambari, CEO PHDRDF and other members of PHDRDF.





C. PHDRDF – HSIL

PHDRDF has partnered with HSIL for a project titled **“Mobile Health Services”**. In this project, HSIL has provided two Mobile Medical Ambulances to PHDRDF to organize free health camps in nearby areas of Bahadurgarh and Kaharani in Haryana. The ambulance vans have been fabricated and equipped with LED screen to diagnose patients with eye problems, undertake awareness camps and other health care treatments. The project will provide generic health care services to the people with testing devices like ECG, blood test facilities like haemoglobin, blood sugar and supported by a qualified medical team consisting of a medical doctor and paramedical staff including lab technician and ANM. Two camps were conducted with more than 200 patients benefitting from these camps.



D. PHDRDF-DHAMPUR SUGAR MILLS LTD.

PHDRDF has partnered with Dhampur Sugar Mills Ltd. for the year 2021-22 to implement CSR project on Healthcare services through Mobile Medical Van at two blocks Dhampur and Rajpura. The Health project will reach out to villagers in 20 villages; 10 each at Rajpura and Dhampur. As a part of the project, generic health camps, eye care camps and women & child health care camps will be organized across the specified villages. Lives of more than 40, 000 villagers will benefit from the project in one year.

PHDRDF- SHIKSHA- A SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Access to quality education plays a vital role in improving the socio economic conditions of the rural communities. PHDRDF Shiksha aims to provide quality and equitable education to the less privileged children. PHDRDF is partnering with corporate and PSU's to upgrade the quality of education and infrastructure in government schools.

Overview of various School Development Projects

A. PHDRDF- AICF (ASIAN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF WESTERN NEW YORK)

PHDRDF and AICF- a New York based Charitable Foundation partnered to undertake the development activities in Govt. Upper Primary School, Dantli in Jamwaramgarh block of Jaipur in Rajasthan as a part of their socio economic development projects in India. Drinking water station, toilet block were refurbishment/ constructed, Educational wall art, whitewash and fans were installed/ undertaken. The school did not have proper drinking water facility and a borewell facility for water resource was established at the school benefitting more than 202 school children.



B. PHDRDF- DR AWASTY & FAMILY

Dr Awasty, a doctor based in US has collaborated with PHDRDF to upgrade the infrastructural facility of 'Advaita Garden Children's Village' School in Hajipur, Alwar, Rajasthan, he adopted. A new toilet cum bathroom block was constructed. Electrical wiring, ceiling fans, tubelights, new windows and doors alongwith whitewash was also done in the classrooms. Around 350 students have been benefitted from this project.



D. PHDRDF - HSIL

PHDRDF and HSIL have partnered to develop sanitation facility for girl students in 5 Government schools in 5 villages in Bahadurgarh block of Jhajjar District, Haryana. Seven blocks toilet each consisting of toilet and urinals have been refurbished/ reconstructed in schools located in village Rohad, Dehkora, Mandothi, Asaudha and Kulasi. The project will benefit more than 786 girls.



C. PHDRDF- DONALDSON FILTERS INDIA PVT. LTD.



PHDRDF and Donaldson Filters India Pvt. Ltd. partnered to support Government Middle School, Naharpur, Kasan in Haryana by providing 8 desktop computers and established a computer lab.

D. PHDRDF- HINDUSTAN TIN WORKS LIMITED

PHDRDF and Hindustan Tin Works Limited partnered and established new girls toilet block and refurbished boys toilet of a Government Upper Primary School in Dhaturi Village, Sonapat, Haryana that will benefit more than 250 students. The establishment of toilets in school will promote better health and hygiene practices amongst the students, leading to better health in the community. This will also ensure the improvement in the attendance of the students in school.



PHDRDF- *JAL SANCHAYAN*- WATER HARVESTING INTERVENTION

PHDRDF *Jal Sanchayan* aims to improve and restore the natural water resource base through construction of Water Harvesting Structures. 24 Rain Water Harvesting structures including Check Dams and Pond were established to

augment the natural flow of water into the underground reservoirs thereby improving the water resources of the area and aid water conservation. Effort by PHDRDF in Jal Sanchayan has improved the access to water in the villages for both agricultural and domestic use.

Brief overviews of the water harvesting projects implemented by PHD Rural Development Foundation this year are as follows.

A. PHDRDF-COCA COLA FOUNDATION

PHDRDF and The Coca Cola India have partnered together to promote sustainable solutions for water resource management with surface water conservation and ground water recharge, through construction of 07 check dams in water-stressed two blocks of Ranchi District – Kanke and Ratu in Jharkhand. The project will reach out to more than 15,000 people, creating a total water recharge capacity of 292,100 cubic meters. Good rainfall has been received in Jharkhand and water has been filled in the check dams established. This will help the farmers in the area with richer soil for irrigation.



B. PHDRDF- FACULTY OF MANAGEMENT STUDIES BATCH OF 1979-81

PHDRDF and FMS Batch of 1979-81 (University of Delhi) have partnered together to construct one rain water harvesting structure 'Gularwala check dam' in Hajipur Village, Alwar, Rajasthan with a length of 65 ft. The check dam will have a water holding capacity of 275000 cubic feet. The check dam will help a population of 4500 with increased ground water table.



PHDRDF- HINDUSTAN TIN WORKS LIMITED



PHDRDF and Hindustan Tin Works Ltd. have partnered together for pond rejuvenation in Bhigan Village, Sonipat, Haryana. Concrete footpath of 360 meters with lock ‘n’ lock tiles have been paved around the pond and RCC benches have been installed already. Furthermore, solar street lights and trees with tree guard have been planted around the pond with an objective of soil conservation and green cover. The pond is being developed for villagers use, as a park for walk ways and other recreational activities.

C. PHDRDF – ROTARY CLUB OF DELHI SOUTH CENTRAL

PHDRDF and Rotary Club of Delhi South Central have partnered together for establishment of four water harvesting structures in Alwar, Rajasthan. The check dams will have a total water holding capacity of 13,45,000 cubic feet. One of the check dams, namely, Mandir Wala was sponsored & inaugurated by Ms. Kamla Devi along with Mr. Sanjay Aggarwal, President, PHDCCI; Mr. Sandeep Aggarwal, Mentor- Telecom Committee, PHDCCI & other family members, team of Rotary, Mr. Saurabh Sanyal, Secretary General PHDCCI, Sarpanch and villagers. The other 03 check dams were also inaugurated by the team of Rotarians led by Mr. Arun Kataruka and other members from the Club.



D. PHDRDF- POLYPLEX CORPORATION LTD. AND DR RAJESH MALHOTRA

PHDRDF with co-sponsorship of Polyplex Corporation Limited and Dr Rajesh Malhotra based in USA have partnered together for establishment of one water harvesting structure '**Firavwala Check Dam**' in Dadhikar, Hajipur, Alwar, Rajasthan with a length of 175 ft. The check dam will have a water holding capacity of 7,35,000 cubic feet.



E. PHDRDF- KAJARIA CERAMICS LIMITED

PHDRDF with Kajaria Ceramics Limited have partnered together for establishment of one water harvesting structure '**Thakur wala Check Dam**' in Kaaled Banada Ki Dhani, Samra, Alwar, Rajasthan with a length of 180 ft. The check dam with water holding capacity of 3,00,000 cubic feet is completed with active participation from the community.



F. PHDRDF- RADICO NV DISTILLERIES MAHARASHTRA PVT. LTD., SELECT CITY WALK AND MR K S MEHTA & FAMILY

PHDRDF with Radico NV Distilleries Maharashtra Pvt. Ltd., Select City Walk and Mr. K S Mehta & Family have partnered together for establishment of one water harvesting structure '**Devrawala Check Dam**' in Thanagazi, Alwar, Rajasthan with a length of 320 ft. The check dam will have a water holding capacity of 4, 48, 000 cubic feet. This check dam will help in augmentation of the water table and recharge the ground water.



G. PHDRDF- PTC INDIA FINANCIAL SERVICE LTD. & PTC FOUNDATION TRUST

PHDRDF with PTC India Financial Service Ltd. & PTC Foundation Trust have partnered together for establishment of four water harvesting structures & two Gabion structures in Rajgarh, Alwar, Rajasthan. The check dams will have a water holding capacity of 21, 67,500 cubic feet and help with augmentation of the water table and recharge the groundwater. Two structures were duly completed and received rain during the monsoon season.



H. PHDRDF – ROTARY CLUB OF MANTHAN & ROTARY CLUB OF DELHI WEST

PHDRDF and Rotary Club of Manthan & Rotary Club of Delhi West have partnered together for establishment of one water harvesting structure 'Chatatan Wala CD' in Alwar, Rajasthan with a length of 55 ft. The establishment of check dam with water holding capacity of 72,000 cubic feet has been completed with support from the community. The dam was inaugurated on June 23, 2021 by Mr. NK Lamba, President RC Manthan and Mr. Arun Rungta, President RC DW in presence of Dr Kadambari, CEO PHDRDF and was handed over to the community.



I. PHDRDF –ROTARY CLUB OF DELHI SOUTH CENTRAL



PHDRDF with support of Rotary Club of Delhi South Central inaugurated 04 check dams at Sikar, Rajasthan. The check dams were inaugurated by the team of Rotarians including Mr. Dharmesh Mehta, President of Rotary Club of Delhi South Central; Mr. Arun Kataruka Secretary; Mr. Dinesh Jain, Mr. Mukesh Agarwal and Mr. Sandeep Aggarwal and other members of the club in presence of Mr. Suresh Modi, MLA NeemKa Thana, Sikar. Dr Kadambari, CEO PHDRDF; Mr. Brajmohan, Manager Water Resources and other members of PHDRDF were present during the inauguration.

J. PHDRDF AND FMS BATCH 1979-81

PHDRDF and FMS batch 1981 have partnered together to construct one water harvesting structure 'Kumhar wala CD' in Jaipur, Rajasthan with a length of 70 ft. The check dam will have a water holding capacity of 280,000 cubic feet. The donor supported for establishment of a check dam namely Pali Wala in the same village in 2019.



K. PHDRDF – SS KOTHARI AND FAMILY

PHDRDF and S.S Kothari and family represented by Mr. KS Mehta have partnered together to construct one water harvesting structure 'Bhairujiwala' in Hajipur Village, Alwar, Rajasthan with a length of 110 ft. The check dam will have water holding capacity of 6, 16, 600 cubic feet. This check dam will help augmentation of the water table and recharge the groundwater. The construction work towards the check dam has been completed with active participation from the community.




L. PHDRDF – VISHNU CHARITABLE (DALMIA BHARAT)

PHDRDF and Vishnu Charitable (Dalmia Bharat) have partnered together to construct one water harvesting structure ‘Khali Kuan ’ in Hajipur Village, Alwar, Rajasthan with a length of 99 ft. The check dam will have a water holding capacity of 360,000 cubic feet. The construction work towards the check dam has been completed with active participation from the community. This check dam received good rainfall during the monsoon season and received overflowing water.



M. PHDRDF- ORIENTAL CARBON & CHEMICAL LIMITED AND HINDUSTAN TIN WORKS LIMITED

PHDRDF and Oriental Carbon & Chemical Ltd. & Hindustan Tin Works Ltd. have partnered together for establishment of one water harvesting structure ‘Mewawala CD’ in Hajipur, Alwar, Rajasthan with a length of 90 ft. The check dam having water holding capacity of 221,375 cubic feet will help in augmentation of the water table and recharge the groundwater. The establishment of the check dam has been completed with active participation and support from the community. The check dam was inaugurated on September 4,2021 by Mr. Sanjay Bhatia, MD HTWL and Chairman PHDRDF in presence of Mr. KS Mehta, former Chairman PHDRDF. Dr Kadambari CEO, PHDRDF, members of PHDRDF and villagers were present during the inauguration.



N. PHDRDF-DHAMPUR SUGAR MILLS LTD.

PHDRDF has partnered with Dhampur Sugar Mills Ltd. for the year 2021-22 to implement the project for “**Rain water harvesting**” structure to be established at PushpNiketan School in Dhampur, Uttar Pradesh. Two recharge shafts with a depth of 45 m each will be established that will help collect 7347000 litres of water which will further help in recharging the ground water table in a year.



PHDRDF VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT

PHDRDF has been actively working towards supporting the villagers in rural area by providing water and toilet facilities in different states.

A. PHDRDF-HINDUSTAN TIN WORKS LIMITED



PHDRDF and Hindustan Tin Works Limited have partnered for providing **Pucca house** facility to BPL Family a resident of village Painta at Madhubani, Bihar. The existing house of the beneficiary consisted of thatched roof and did not have any provision of a proper kitchen and sanitation facility. As part of the project, the BPL beneficiary has been supported with a proper pucca house including two rooms, kitchen, toilet and bath-room. Proper plaster,

tilling, electric fitting and water facility will be additionally provided. The project has been completed with all the basic facilities for protection from poor health and natural calamities.

PHDRDF EVENTS


A. INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY CELEBRATION- MORE POWER TO WOMEN OF TOMORROW!

PHDRDF celebrated international women's day on March 6, 2021 by providing self-defence training to more than 70 adolescent girls and women from low-income and minority dominating areas in rural pockets of Sohna and Siddhrawali, Pataudi in Haryana. The focus was on conditioning the youth overall.



B. MENSTRUAL HYGIENE DAY

PHDRDF celebrated “Menstrual Hygiene Day” by organizing an interactive session on “Menstrual Health & Hygiene: Best Practices” on May 28, 2021. The objective of the session was to educate rural girls and women on menstrual hygiene, need of nutrition during the days and awareness on sanitary products. The session was attended by girls & women from five states.



C. TIKA UTSAV -APRIL 11 -14, 2021

As part of 'TikaUtsav' (April 11-14, 2021), PHD Rural Development Foundation organized awareness drives on

importance of getting vaccinated. The awareness drive was carried out in different locations like Sohna, Pataudi, Sonipat in Haryana, district of Alwar in Rajasthan, Ranchi in Jharkhand and Dhampur, Sambhal district of Uttar Pradesh.

D. WORLD WATER DAY- March 22, 2021



PHDRDF celebrated World Water Day by raising awareness regarding judicious use of water with community members in Rajasthan & Jharkhand. The World Water Day celebrates water and raises awareness on the global water crisis, and a core focus of the observance is to support the achievement of Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 6: water and sanitation for all by 2030.

E. POSHAN MAAH- September 2021



PHD Rural Development Foundation celebrated “Poshan Maah- September 2021” under “POSHAN Abhiyaan” Scheme of Ministry of Women & Child Development. As part of the campaign, on September 4, 2021, Mr. Sanjay Bhatia, Chairman PHDRDF in presence of Mr. KS Mehta, Former Chairman, PHDRDF distributed 4-5 Fruit Plants to individual households in Alwar, Rajasthan to encourage consumption of nutritional food. Aonla fruit plants were also handed over to the Principal Govt. School, Hajipur to be planted in school premises. In the course of the month, PHDRDF will be organizing awareness generation sessions among children and especially adolescent girls across 4 states on importance of nutritious diet and adapting healthy eating habits.

Way Forward

Economy of villages is dependent on agriculture; therefore, focussing our efforts towards empowering the farmers with sustainable agriculture practices to ensure economic stability for the villages. PHDRDF has been working in water conservation for more than a decade and has established 270+ rain water harvesting structures across 5 states with a maximum focus in Rajasthan. As a step forward, PHDRDF has initiated a project on fruit plantation to help enhance farmers' income and support the government initiative of doubling farmers' income by 2022. The project was initiated under the leadership of Mr. Sanjay Bhatia, Chairman, PHDRDF and Mr. K S Mehta, Past Chairman, PHDRDF along with Dr Kadambari, CEO and PHDRDF team. As a part of the project, PHDRDF planted more than 1500 fruit trees -Amla, Lemon and Papaya in Alwar and Sikar. The target of the initiative is to plant 25000 fruit plants every year and engage more farmers. Additional livelihood activities on enhancing income are being evaluated to be undertaken in the coming year.
