## PHD RURAL DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION



PHD Rural Development Foundation actively works in Healthcare-Arogya, Education-Shiksha, Skill Development-Saksham, Water Conservation-Jal Sanchayan and Village development. During 2022-23, a total of 50 different projects were undertaken with support from various donors, impacting the lives of more than 1.6 lakh people across 8 states covering 30 Districts. During the period, 137 Rain Water Harvesting structures including check dams and 7 pond rejuvenation were established with a water holding capacity of 15.00 lakh cu. ft.; 1050 health camps, 285 OPDs were organized under difficult circumstances treating more than 55,000 patients; 130 young girls & women and youth were trained in different skill sets; 6 Government schools were upgraded with better infrastructure facilities benefitting more than 1600 children and more than 1.5 lakh saplings of fruit trees were planted.

## A. PHDRDF- FRUIT PLANTATION FOR INCOME ENHANCEMENT OF FARMERS



PHDRDF with the support of multiple partners initiated a project on “Enhancing Farmer’s Income through Fruit Plantation” by distributing and planting saplings of Fruit Trees such as Aonla, Lemon, Apple, Ber, Mausami and Papaya. Some of the partners are Polyplex Limited, Havells India Ltd., Olam Agro India Ltd., ML Bharti Foundation, S.S. Kothari Mehta & Co., Hindustan Tin Works Limited, Kamla Gupta Memorial Trust, Dalmia Cement (Bharat) Limited, TCI Foundation, Calpro Food Essential Pvt. Ltd., DCM

Shriram Foundation, FMS Batch of 1981, J.K. Fenner (India) Limited, Raffbrix Private Limited, RSWM Ltd., JK Laxmi Cement and others. So far, 1.5 lakh fruit plants have been distributed to 400 farmers in 80 villages across two districts in Rajasthan. 20 members from FMS Batch 1981 also contributed to plant 13,500 fruit saplings. 260 lemon saplings were also planted in Gautam Budh Nagar with support from Mr. Abhinav Khare.

## B. PHDRDF – MUNICIPAL CORPORATION HARIDWAR- RECYCLED PLASTIC WASTE MANAGEMENT



PHDRDF collaborated with Municipal Corporation Haridwar for a novel pilot initiative on Environment/ Waste Management and established a link road to Material Recovery Facility at Sarai, using 50 kgs of

Recycled Plastic Waste. The project was executed under the technical guidance of Mr. Ashish Wig, Senior Management Committee Member, PHDCCI.

## C. PHDRDF - LEGRAND INDIA PRIVATE LTD.- HARIDWAR



PHDRDF partnered with Group Legrand India under their Environment Initiative to promote renewable energy and reduce carbon footprint. Under this initiative, 50 solar street lights of 75 W solar panel and a 30V battery were installed in Aneki, Hetampur Village, Haridwar. The solar streetlights impacted the lives of approximately 7000 villagers by

empowering them to move out safely even during the late hours of the evening. The handholding ceremony of these lights to the villagers was done on June 5, 2023 on World Environment Day in the presence of Mr. Surinder Mattoo, Plant Head, Legrand India, Haridwar and other team members of Group Legrand India and PHDRDF.

## D. PHDRDF- ROTARY CLUB OF RENDEZVOUS - PALWAL



PHDRDF in partnership with Svarn Infratel Pvt. Ltd. and Rotary Club of Rendezvous installed a 13kW and 10 kW hybrid solar power plants at PHC Alawalpur, District Palwal and UHC SGM Nagar, Faridabad District respectively. This project will benefit around 1,10,000 people in Faridabad district and 2,46,000 people in Palwal.

An OPD centre at PHC Barota, Karnal has also been initiated effective March 2023.

## D. PHDRDF- DHAMPUR BIO ORGANICS LIMITED – SAMBHAL, BAREILLY & MUZAFFARNAGAR



PHDRDF with the support of Dhampur Bio Organics Limited, provided free medical services in 28 villages near the three factory locations of DBOL in Asmoli (Sambhal), Meerganj (Bareilly), and Mansurpur (Muzaffarnagar). The project encompassed three types of camps consisting

Generic, Women & Child Health Camps and Specialized Eye Care Camps, along with awareness sessions. A total of 19,453 patients were treated through 184 Health Camps. This partnership continues to positively impact the health and well-being of the communities involved.

## E. PHDRDF - DHAMPUR SUGAR MILLS LTD.- BIJNOR & MEERUT

PHDRDF with support from Dhampur Sugar Mills Ltd. is conducting health camps in 115 villages near the plant of DSML at Rajpura and Dhampur in Uttar Pradesh. Between October 2022 and March 2023, more than 9522 patients were treated and given free medicines through Generic Health Camps and Eye care camps. The beneficiaries were given free access to a variety of health services including counselling, treatment, and facilities for testing conditions like diabetes, blood pressure and haemoglobin levels.



## F. PHDRDF - TALWANDI SABO POWER LIMITED - MANSA



PHDRDF in association with Talwandi Sabo Power Limited (TSPL) undertook a community health project-SEHAT (Safe and Effective Health Action by TSPL) at Mansa, Punjab; under which 192 OPDs (general, gynaec & dental), clinical laboratory and healthcare services at PHC,

Behniwal were administered along with organizing 80 health camps (generic, eye, awareness) in seven villages benefitting around 7000 people. The patient's health record data is being maintained digitally for easy examination of the patients and for easy access to patient's medical history.

## G. PHDRDF - RADICO KHAITAN LTD.- SITAPUR



PHDRDF and Radico Khaitan Ltd. have partnered to implement the Project "Sashakt". ## PHDRDF – SKILL DEVELOPMENT

PHDRDF under Saksham - the skill development program trained 129 adolescent girls and women were trained in stitching, beauty culture and computer skills during the period.

### A. PHDRDF - DONALDSON INDIA FILTER SYSTEMS PRIVATE LIMITED - GURUGRAM

Continuing the partnership with Donaldson India Filter Systems Pvt. Ltd., PHDRDF trained 80 students in stitching & tailoring and beauty culture at the Skill Development Centre of Mohammadpur Gurjar, Sohna block, Gurugram. Under the aegis of this project, till date more than 650 students have completed their training at the Center. Most of the girls are taking up small assignments in their neighbourhood and earning an average income of Rs 5000- 7000 per month.



### B. PHDRDF - DRI PVT. LTD. - GURUGRAM



PHDRDF with the support of Desiccant Rotors International (DRI) Pvt. Ltd., trained 56 adolescent girls and women in basic computer skills along with spoken English and soft skills at 'DRI Udaan Skill Development Center for Computer Training' in Pataudi, Haryana. On April 26, 2023, certificates were distributed to the students by Ms. Anandita Pahwa, Head-CSR, DRI in the presence of Dr Kadambari Chief Executive PHDRDF; Mr. Sandeep, Manager, PHDRDF; Mr Mahmood, CSR Coordinator, DRI; Sarpanch and villagers. Students extended their gratitude to DRI for the facility provided to them free of cost.

## A. PHDRDF- DHAMPUR SUGAR MILLS LTD.- BIJNOR & SAMBHAL



PHDRDF, in association with Dhampur Sugar Mills Ltd., has rejuvenated four ponds, 2 each in Dhampur, Bijnor district, and Rajpura, Sambhal District, in Uttar Pradesh. The ponds were rejuvenated by desilting, cleaning, embankment,

pathway, solar lights, fencing and other beautification work. The rejuvenation of the pond not just helped in alleviating the groundwater level, but also created a clean, safe environment for the community residing in the area.

## B. PHDRDF- ROTARY CLUB OF DELHI MEGAPOLIS – ALWAR



PHDRDF partnered with Rotary Club of Delhi Megapolis to establish Bordya Wala check Dam at Alwar district in Rajasthan with water holding capacity of 2,700,000 cu. ft. During the construction, Rotary Dream Team 2022 visited the site from November 24–28, 2022 to support the villagers

in building of check dam as part of 'Shramdan'. During this visit, the stone signage was also unveiled by Rotarian team led by Mr. Sanjeev Saran, Project Manager India and Mr. Elias Thomas, Project Leader USA in the presence of other Rotarians, PHDRDF team and the villagers.

## C. PHDRDF- ROTARY CLUB OF DELHI SOUTH CENTRAL- ALWAR & AJMER



With the joint efforts of PHDRDF and the Rotary Club of Delhi South Central, eight check dams, 03 in Ajmer and 5 in Alwar were established with a consolidated water-holding capacity of 15,12,000 cubic feet. The inauguration of the check dams was done by the team of Rotarians led by Mr.

Rajneesh Mittal, villagers and the RDF team on March 9, 2023 and June 28, 2023 respectively. The project will help in recharging the ground water level in the area and benefit the community residing in the nearby locations.

## D. PHDRDF- PRESS TRUST OF INDIA- ALWAR

PHDRDF with support from The Press Trust of India established Band wala Check Dam in Alwar, Rajasthan. On May 2, 2023, the dam was inaugurated by Ms. Urmila Mozumder, CFO PTI in presence of Mr. Anoop Nair, CSR Cordinator PTI, Dr. Kadambari, CEO PHDRDF, villagers and team from PHDRDF. The PTI team interacted with villagers and understood the significance of the dam from their perspective. Villagers extended their gratitude towards the donor for their effort to help them raise ground water. This initiative will create a water holding capacity of 6,44,000 cubic feet.



## E. PHDRDF- J K TYRE INDUSTRIES LIMITED- JAIPUR

PHDRDF collaborated with J K Tyre Industries Limited to establish BanjaroWala Check Dam in Jaipur, Rajasthan with a water holding capacity of 9,24,000 cubic feet. The structure will aid in ground water recharge of the area leading to access to water to the farmer community for irrigation purposes.



## F. PHDRDF- MRS BECTORS FOOD SPECIALITIES LTD. - PATIALA



PHDRDF with support from Mrs Bector Food Specialities Ltd. rejuvenated a pond at Kami Kalan village, Rajpura, Punjab. The inauguration was done by performing Ardas, Degh and Sarupa on June 2, 2023 in the presence of Mr. Vijay Sharma, Manager – HR, Mrs Bector Food

Specialities along with Mr. Nitish Rai, Manager-Water Resource, PHDRDF and community members. The pond has been developed on chamber-based strategy on sedimentation technology.

and reviewed the impact of plants along with previously sponsored projects. FMS has sponsored 02 check dams, Community Water Station, Solar Lights and up-gradation of the government school in the past.

## K. PHDRDF- ORIENTAL CARBON & CHEMICAL LIMITED-ALWAR

PHDRDF established a rain water harvesting structure named 'Ganga Wala Check Dam' at Alwar in Rajasthan in association with OCCL to promote sustainable solutions for water resource management. The check dam with the water holding capacity of 392,000 cu. ft. will benefit a population of 1822 and aid in ground water recharge



## L. PHDRDF- VARUN BEVERAGES LTD.- BUNDI

With the collaborative efforts of PHDRDF and Varun Beverages Limited, two rain water harvesting structures named Puliawala check dam and Hanuman Mandirwala check dam were established at Bundi in Rajasthan to promote sustainable solutions for water resource management. The work towards the establishment of the check dams was initiated with a ground breaking ceremony on December 1, 2022. With the completion of the construction of structures, a combined water holding potential of 333,850 cubic metres has been generated in the area, which will aid in ground water recharge and provide farmers an access to water.





### M. PHDRDF- RCDSC & MULTIVAC LARAON PVT. LTD. – ALWAR

PHDRDF together with Rotary Club of Delhi South Central & MultivacLaraonPvt. Ltd. as a part of Rotary- CSR initiative is undertaking construction of two rainwater harvesting structure at Block Rasgan, Alwar, Rajasthan,

which will have the water holding capacity of 14,22,000 cubic feet. The project is under progress and it aims to elevate the water levels in the nearby areas.

### N. PHDRDF- GULSHAN CHEMICALS PVT. LIMITED – ALWAR

PHDRDF in association with Gulshan Chemicals Pvt. Limited partnered to establish a rainwater harvesting structure at Kaler, Alwar, Rajasthan. The check dam will have a water holding capacity of 10, 32,000 cubic feet, and will help the community in the nearby areas achieve water sustainability.



### O. PHDRDF- ROTARY CLUB DELHI LUTEYNS- ALWAR

PHDRDF and Rotary Club of Delhi Lutyens joined hands to establish five rainwater harvesting structure at Rajgarh, Alwar, Rajasthan. The structures will aid in ground water recharge and benefit the population living in the nearby vicinity. The agriculture land will become more suitable for cultivation due to increased moisture content. This project targets to increase the water holding capacity of the region by 14,07,000 cubic feet and make water available for the locals.



### P. PHDRDF- ROTARY CLUB OF DELHI SOUTH EAST-ALWAR



With the joint efforts of PHDRDF and the Rotary Club of Delhi South East, 43 small Water Harvesting Structures check dams are being established at Alwar. These water harvesting structures have a water holding capacity of 4,30,000 cubic feet. Out of these, 43



structures, eleven structures were inaugurated on June 3, 2023, and other nine were inaugurated on June 26, 2023 in the presence of Mr.Arun Gupta, President of Rotary Club of Delhi South East and other dignitaries which were led by Mr. Sudip Kohli.

## Q. PHDRDF- ECHOPE – JAIPUR

PHDRDF partnered with ECHOPE as a part of a WALKATHON to establish a rainwater harvesting structure at Neemla, Jaipur, Rajasthan in India with a water holding capacity of 4,62,200 cubic feet. The dam was inaugurated by Dr Pragti, ECHOPE in presence of Dr Kadambari, CEO PHDRDF, Mr. Brajmohan, Manager PHDRDF, Sarpanch and Villagers.



## R. PHDRDF- DONALDSON INDIA FILTER SYSTEMS PVT. LTD. – ALWAR

PHDRDF partnered with Donaldson India Filter Systems Pvt. Ltd. to establish a rainwater harvesting structure at RundhSirawas, Alwar, Rajasthan. The check dam will have a water holding capacity of 3,13,600 cubic feet.

Besides benefitting agriculture land, it will also benefit more than 5000 livestock of farmers by providing them water for drinking purposes.

## S. PHDRDF- ROTARY CLUB DELHI ASHOKA- ALWAR & NOIDA

PHDRDF collaborated with Rotary Club of Delhi Ashoka to establish two rainwater harvesting structures and rejuvenate one pond in Rajgarh, Alwar, Rajasthan & Gautam Budh Nagar, Greater Noida (U.P) respectively. The check dams have been completed and received substantial water during the monsoon in July 2023. This project will create a combined water holding potential of 13,89,858 cubic feet.



## T. PHDRDF- DHANUKA AGRITECH- JAIPUR



PHDRDF partnered with Dhanuka Agritech to establish a rainwater harvesting structure PanihariWala Check Dam in Jaipur, Rajasthan. The check dam has a water holding capacity of 6,30,000 cubic feet that will benefit a population



of 3583. Establishing Rain Water harvesting structures is one of the most significant methods to promote ground water recharge and conserve water in rural areas.

## U. PHDRDF- DIXON TECHNOLOGIES INDIA LIMITED- JAIPUR

PHDRDF in association with Dixon Technologies India Limited established a rainwater harvesting structure Dairy Wala Check Dam in Jaipur, Rajasthan. The check dam has a water holding capacity of 2,60,000 cubic feet. The structure will aid in ground water recharge of the area leading to access of water to the farmer community for irrigation purposes.



## V. PHDRDF -RCDSE & AARGUS GLOBAL LOGISTICS PVT. LTD.- ALWAR



PHDRDF joined hands with Rotary Club of Delhi South East & Aargus Global Logistics Pvt. Ltd. as a part of Rotary- CSR initiative to work on establishing two rainwater harvesting structures at Block Sirawas, Alwar, Rajasthan. The combined water holding capacity of these

two check dams is 14,70,000 cubic feet, whose ground breaking ceremony was held on June 26, 2023 in the presence of Mr. Mahesh, President, Aargus Global Logistics Pvt. Ltd. and his family, which was led by Mr. Sudip Kohli.

## W. PHDRDF -ROTARY CLUB OF DELHI CENTRAL- ALWAR



PHDRDF with support of Rotary Club of Delhi Central is working to establish four rainwater harvesting structures in Alwar, Rajasthan, with a combined water holding potential of 28,89,600 cubic feet. The project was initiated with a Bhumi Pujan ceremony on March 26, 2023 in the presence

of a team of Rotarians led by Mr. Sanjay Aggarwal, Former President, PHDCCI, villagers and RDF Team followed by Dhol and folk music and the villagers thanked the Rotary Team for their support. The Club during last year established 51 small water Harvesting structures in Alwar.



## X. PHDRDF - COCA COLA INDIA FOUNDATION – PALGHAR



PHDRDF with support from Coca Cola India are establishing nine rainwater harvesting structures with a combined water holding capacity of 1,31,71,089 cubic feet in Palghar, Maharashtra. As a part of the project, fruit

plantation is also being undertaken as part of watershed treatment. The structures will aid in ground water recharge and will benefit the tribal population of 21,980.

## PHDRDF OTHER EVENTS

### A. PHDRDF – KADIMI TOOLS MANUFACTURING COMPANY (PVT.) LTD.- NEW DELHI

PHDRDF and Kadimi Tool Manufacturing Company (Pvt.) Limited distributed blankets to people living in Majlis Park Hindu Refugee Camp on December 16, 2022. This project was started to assist the camp's refugees to survive the winters. Along with the blankets, stationery sets were also distributed to the camp's children in an effort to support their academic endeavors. Both Mr. S.S. Chouhan (HR Head-Kadimi Tools) and Mr. Nikhil Bhardwaj from PHDRDF were present during the programme.



### B. PHDRDF – HINDUSTAN TIN WORKS LTD.- MADHUBANI



With support from the Hindustan Tin Works Limited, PHDRDF supported a BPL family in village Paita, Madhubani, Bihar with a pakka house in-place of a thatched roof mud house without any provision for a proper kitchen or sanitation facility. A proper pakka house

including two rooms, a kitchen, a toilet and a bathroom along with electrical and water facility was constructed which will protect the family from poor health and natural calamities.
